Impact of FTAs on OSH – Overview of challenges



Growth of hazardous industries (poor quantitative data)

FTAs with no or very general OSH commitments

(e.g.: Africa, Turkey, upcoming China)

Poor monitoring of OSH commitments

(labour standards often not a priority for TSD Committees)

No enforcement

(no or limited dispute settlement)

Positive influence of approximation of OSH laws

(improvement of labour inspectorates in Moldova, Georgia)



Tentative recommendations



□ Develop better intelligence

- => Quantitative data
- ⇒ Qualitative interviews

- □Broader discussions on upgrading of Global South in GVC
- ⇒Industrial policies

Growth of hazardous industries (poor quantitative data)



□ Obligation to ratify ILO Core Conventions as a pre-condition

⇒Resistance from partner countries?

□ Additional norm setting to address significant most dangerous industries

- => Non core ILO Conventions
- ⇒ISO standards (with appropriate caution)

FTAs with no or very general OSH commitments

(e.g.: Africa, Turkey, upcoming China)

Positive influence of approximation of OSH laws

(improvement of labour inspectorates in Moldova, Georgia)



□ Leverage the CSDDD

- ⇒ Obligation on EU multinationals
- ⇒ As a precondition to foreign investment
- ⇒ Ex of concrete measures: Bangladesh Accord
- ☐ A role for the European Labour Authority (joint inspections)
- => Increased budget for national systems
- ☐ Improved functioning of TSD committees

Poor monitoring of OSH commitments

(labour standards often not a priority for TSD Committees)



□ A Rapid Response Mechanism

- ⇒Ex USMCA
- □ Sanctions on offending company/ investor
- ⇒Suspension of tariff benefits for goods produced at the company
- ⇒HRDD sanctions
- ☐ Cooperation and capacity building mechanisms must be upheld

No enforcement

(no or limited dispute settlement)



Prioritising review of FTAs with poor OSH protection and under review

- □Euro-Mediterranean Association Agreement
- ⇒No OSH provision
- **DEU-Mexico Global Agreement**
- ⇒Low priority to labour rights
- □ Eastern and Southern Africa Interim and Economic Partnership Agreement
- ⇒No TSD
- ⇒ Cooperation on OSH in mining only
- **DEU-Azerbaijan Partnership and Cooperation Agreement**
- => No TSD
